BEST OF THE BEST QUALIFICATIONS

The Qualifying Event must consist of the following competition requirements:

- Contain A, B, & C Age Categories
- Complete a dance-off between 2 or 3 of the age groups—no automatic winners without a dance-off.
- Receive a letter and an Application Form for the qualifying student
- The chairman or official will give the winner of the dance-off a letter and the Application Form
- The Application Form must be *correctly* completed and mailed to the following address: P. O. Box 14442, Columbus, OH 43214
- The Application Form must be mailed one month before the Ohio Star Deadline.
- A Dance picture must be submitted with the application.
- No verbal entries will be accepted.

The Classifications include the following 3 categories:

1. Closed Syllabus Bronze, Silver, Gold, and Gold Advanced (Open) categories:

Routines must not exceed 1 min and 30 sec. (Includes set up and exit.) Routine must have 2 people, 1 male and 1 female. Closed Bronze, Silver, and Gold steps must be limited to the closed syllabus level being danced, however you may include 5 steps above your current level. Gold Advanced (Open) category may include any open steps. Two lifts are allowed, but not overhead and must not exceed 15 secs. See rules below regarding props and costumes.

 Props and dresses - No props shall be permitted during entrance, performance and exit. "Props" shall include such items of furniture and items that are not a part of your costume. Fans, capes and hats are permissible if not discarded. Choice of dress for the man and lady must be chosen to suit and complement the theme of the solo performance in either Ballroom or Latin style. Taking off clothes and discarding them during the performance is not permissible.

2. Showdance Categories (all levels):

Routines must not exceed 2 min. (Includes set up and exit.) Showdance does not fall into the closed level categories, may have 2 or more participants, and number of lifts are not limited. There are no restrictions to Props and Costumes in this category.

3. Theater Arts Categories (all levels):

Routines must not exceed 3 min. (Includes set up and exit.) Theater Arts does not fall into the closed level categories, may have 2 or more participants, and number of lifts are not limited. There are no restrictions to Props and Costumes in this category.

OHIO STAR BALL FINALE RULES:

- You can qualify at many events and in all styles, but you are limited to only one routine in the Finale.
- Dance picture must be submitted <u>with</u> the application.
- Finale entrants must be an active competitor at the Ohio Star Ball with a <u>minimum of 10 single</u> dance entries.
- The winners of the closed Bronze, closed Silver, Gold/Advance, the overall Show Dance winner, and the overall Theater Arts winner, will be invited to perform an encore dance on Friday evening.
- Prize money will be given in vouchers to be used *only* at *Best of the Best* Events.
- Award amounts: \$600, \$500, \$400, \$300, \$200, and \$100

Please Remember, you must be an active competitor at the Ohio Star Ball.
